1: I have found this chart to be a great tool that you can take a few minutes each day to track your resolutions and to give God thanks. Will you accept this challenge? I would love to hear how God was involved in helping you accomplish your daily resolutions and the things that you are thankful each day. A good question for reflection is "Where have you seen God's Grace?" If you feel that this practice helps you in your daily living, let me encourage you to continue this process for 30 days. It worked for me in the month of September. I tracked 29 wins out of 30 and gave God thanks every day for the evidence of God's Grace. I am going to continue this process through the end of the year.
